## Welcome to Reception!

'The Wonderful World of Fairy Tales', is a lovely topic to settle your child into school life.

Through this familiar topic, we will learn about well-loved traditional tales, such as, 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Little Red Riding Hood', 'Jack and The Beanstalk' and 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. These stories use repetitive language and provide opportunities for role play, extending language, cooking, painting and construction.

During the half term, as the summer draws to a close, we will be noticing the changes in the season as autumn nears. We will collect autumnal objects, such as conkers and acorns in our surrounding area and learn about the animals that are out and about during this season.

The children will also start to learn sounds and form letters to begin to read and write. As well as this, there will be a counting focus on numbers 0-10 and beyond.
