## History

In History, we are going to be learning about King Charles III and the role of a monarch. We will be using sources to find out about monarchs from the past.

#### PE

The PE focus for this half term is 'attack, defend, shoot'. We will practise basic movements including running, jumping, throwing and catching.

## RE

In RE the children will be exploring the question 'How did the world begin?' We will learn about the Christian, Jewish and Hindu Creation stories and how they help some people to understand what God is like.

## Year 1 - Autumn 1

What is a monarch's job?

This half term we will start with a focus on narrative. In Literacy, we will read the story 'The King's Runaway Crown: A Coronation Caper' by Rosalind Spark. We will be retelling the story through drama and oral rehearsal before writing our own short versions.

This half term, we are also looking forward to finding out more about castles. We will read 'National Trust: The Castle the King Built' and we will learn more about non-fiction writing.

In Design and Technology, we are planning and making our own castle models with recycled materials in the style of the sculptor Michelle Reader.

In Science, we will be looking at changes across seasons and using observations to record weather associated with different times of the year. We will start by looking at the seasonal changes in autumn, including changing leaves and wearing suitable clothing.
